# PROGRAM SPOTLIGHT

With a variety of unique Career Education programs, students have the ability to gain a certificate and start in the career of their choice. Below are just a few highlighted programs available at North/Far North Region California community colleges.

#### **Residential Construction (College of the Redwoods)**

Residential Construction program is unique in that students build a complete three bedroom/two bath residential house each academic year and the house is sold in the open market. Students design the home, design/build/install cabinets, build the house, install solar, and perform all major construction duties in order to build the house from foundation to finished home. By the time the house is put on the market, roughly 100 students have had some hand in design and constructing the home.

#### Folsom Lake College Medical Laboratory Technology

Folsom Lake College is the only community college north of the Bay Area that prepares students to qualify for and pass the National Medical Laboratory Technician Licensing exam. Medical laboratory technicians perform a variety of routine tests under the supervision of a clinical laboratory scientist. The tests they run help doctors to diagnose and treat diseases. They perform blood counts, urinalysis, and test cells, tissues, blood and other specimen. Microscopes, automated blood analyzers and other laboratory equipment are commonly used by technicians. The program at Folsom Lake includes aspects of didactic and clinical training to prepare students to step into functioning medical laboratories, either in a hospital or research lab setting. The program has robust prerequisites and is intended to equip completers to execute any aspect of their profession both within and outside California.
